

Guidelines for the Burda Book Awards

A. This scholarship award shall be available only to those graduating seniors who have made application for the same through the Bellaire High School Guidance Office not later than March 1 in the year of graduation.

B. No student applying shall be eligible for the award except those who intend to pursue an education at a Technical College or School.

C. Eligibility for this scholarship shall be any male and female student who has maintained an overall grade point average of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale through February of the year of their graduation as certified by the Bellaire High School Guidance Office on the application, and whose family income is below the Ohio Family Median Income. Eligibility shall be based upon the information provided by the student in the application that will be required in order to apply for the Book Award.

D. The male recipient and female recipient of the award shall be determined on the basis of that male student and that female student whose family median income falls below the Ohio Family Median Income in the year of application, and whose Accumulative Grade Point Average is the highest for each male and female category.

E. An award of \$250.00 shall be payable to each male and each female student selected by the Board of Trustees of the BHS Endowment Fund . In order to be eligible to receive the award, the recipient must enroll in and be accepted to an accredited technical college or school, and payment of the award is contingent upon and payable only after the recipient produces evidence of good standing after completion of their first semester. No funds for the award shall be paid to any person other than the institution.

F. The selection of the male and female recipients shall be made at a regularly scheduled meeting of the BHS Endowment Fund Board of Trustees to be held prior to April 30 preceding the announcement of the award recipients, and will be conferred at the Bellaire High School Awards Assembly to take place in May. The award shall be conferred by a member of the BHS Endowment Fund or its designee.
